The petitioner seeks amendment of the offence mentioned in the bail order in **C.M.P.No.136/2026 dated 10-02-2026.**

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tmt. C. Kanimozhi, Assistant Legal Aid Defence Counsel** Advocate for the Petitioner / Accused and **Thiru. V. Ravichandran, Public Prosecutor,** represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

**ORDER**

**Heard both side.**

The petitioner seeks relaxation of the condition which is already imposed on him in **C.M.P.No136/2026 dated 10-02-2026.**

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner prays to amend the order in CMP No.4730/2025 dated 18-11-2025 and CMP No.136/2026 dated 10-02-2026 since as per the alteration report, the section of law has been omitted to be added in the bail application and prays to allow the petition.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objection.

4. Considering the submission, the orders in CMP Nos.4730/2025, dated 18-11-2025 and 136/2026 dated 10-02-2026 have to be amended so as to rectify the section mentioned in the FIR, hence this Court is inclined to allow the petition and thereby **the section of law mentioned in the C.M.P Nos.4730/2025, dated 18-11-2025 and 136/2026, dated 10-02-2026 are amended as 296(b), 118(1), 105 of BNS and Sec.4 of TNPHW Act instead of Sections 296(b), 118(1), 105 of BNS. In the meantime, it is seen that the case was made over to Sessions Judge, Mahila Court, Coimbatore and the case has been taken on file as SC No.43/2026. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to execute own bond to the satisfaction of the Sessions Judge, Mahila Court, Coimbatore instead of the Judicial Magistrate No.5, Coimbatore.** The other conditions passed by this Court shall stands good and the petitioner shall comply the same.
