This petition filed on behalf of the petitioner to release him on bail u/s.483 of BNS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tmt. / Selvi. S. Nida**, Advocate for the Petitioner / accused and **Thiru. V.Ravichandran, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

**ORDER**

**Heard both side.**

The petitioner is the accused in Crime No.44/2026 of Coimbatore Railway Police Station, for the alleged offence u/s.75 of BNS and Sec.4 of TNPHW Act, he has filed this petition, seeking grant of bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that this petitioner is from a respectable family and he is also a temple priest in a temple and his name does

not find place in the FIR. The petitioner is innocent and he was travelling in the train at the relevant point of time and since there is misconception and hence, the defacto complainant lodged a false complaint. The petitioner never indulged in any such activities as alleged and he is ready to abide any condition and he is in judicial custody for the past 19 days and prays to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

3. Opposing to grant bail to the petitioner, the learned Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner's native place is Erode. Defacto complainant's native place is Coimbatore. On the date of occurrence, the defacto complainant and her brother are travelling in a train in general compartment. The petitioner is also travelling in the same train and both are sitting on the opposite site. All of a sudden, the petitioner shown his private part and the defacto complainant's brother caught red-handed. No previous case is reported against the petitioner. Investigation is in initial stage.

4. After considering the submissions, considering the nature of offence, having regard to the nature of allegation leveled against the petitioner, as investigation is in preliminary stage, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

**Hence, this petition is dismissed.**
