This petition filed on behalf of the petitioners to release them on bail u/s.483 of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tvl. M. Manjuladevi and S. Andavar**, Advocates for the Petitioners / A-3 & A-6 and **Thiru. V. Ravichandran, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

**ORDER**

**Heard both side.**

The petitioners are the accused in Crime No.68/2026 of Saravanamapatti Police Station, for the alleged offence u/s.191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS, they have filed this petition, seeking grant of bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are arrayed as A-3 and A-6. The petitioners filed bail petition before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.2, Coimbatore in C.M.P.No.1965/2026 and the same was

dismissed by the learned Magistrate concerned on 03-03-2026. In this case, co-accused has been enlarged on bail. The petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case and they never indulged in any such activities as alleged and they are ready to abide any condition and they are in judicial custody for the past 37 days and prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

3. Opposing to grant bail to the petitioners, the learned Public Prosecutor submitted that there are six accused in this case. **The petitioners are arrayed as A-3 and A-6.** The defacto complainant and A-1 are friends. A-1 is involved in many other cases and failed to appear before the Court concerned and hence, NBW was ordered against him. After knowing the same, on 02-02-2026, at about 7.00 p.m., the defacto complainant contacted A-1 and informed him about the issuance of NBW and asked him to go to Court for the purpose of recalling the NBW. On the same day at about 10.30 p.m., A-1 called the defacto complainant through phone and picked up quarrel with the defacto complainant and abused him with filthy language stating that he is acting as informer to the police and asked him to come to the place of occurrence. As such, the defacto complainant went to the place of occurrence and A-1 and other accused were present in the place of occurrence, and all the accused picked up quarrel with the defacto complainant and abused him with filthy language and assaulted him with iron rod and caused head injury and criminally intimidated him and fled away from that place. Due to the assault made by the accused, the defacto complainant sustained head injury and he was admitted in the hospital on 03-02-2026 and discharged on 08-03-2026. **Except the present case, the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner is involved in four other cases, in which, one case is registered for the offence u/s.302 of IPC. No previous case is reported against the 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner.** Investigation is still going on.

4. After considering the submissions, considering the nature of offence, though the petitioners are in judicial custody for the past 37 days and no previous case is reported against the 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner, considering the nature of injury caused to the victim and period of treatment taken by the victim, considering the bad antecedents of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner, as investigation is still pending, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

**Hence, this petition is dismissed.**
