This petition has been filed through **e-Filing** on behalf of the petitioner to release him on anticipatory bail u/s.482 of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tvl. T. Nambikkai Domic, T. Dhanushiya, T. Thanalakshmi, B. Karpagavalli and S. Mythili**, Advocates for the Petitioner / Accused and **Thiru. V. Ravichandran, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

ORDER

Heard both side.

The petitioner is the accused in Crime No.38/2026 of Ramanathapuram Police Station, since he is apprehending arrest in the hands of the respondent police for the alleged u/s.194(3) of BNSS, he has filed this petition, seeking grant of Anticipatory bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the earlier anticipatory bail application was dismissed by this Court in CMP No.816/2026 on 03-03-2026. The petitioner and the deceased loved each other and got married in the

year 2025. While so, the deceased committed suicide and died on 18-01-2026. The petitioner is not the reason for her suicide. The petitioner will neither abscond nor tamper the witnesses and prays for grant of anticipatory bail to him.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the defacto complainant is the father of the deceased. A-1 and the deceased were husband and wife. A-2 is the aunt of A-1. A-3 and A-4 are sons of A-2. A-1 and the deceased loved each other and got married in the month of January 2025 against the will of the defacto complainant. Later, the defacto complainant gave 3½ sovereigns of gold jewels to the deceased as sridhana. Investigation reveals that, from the date of marriage, the accused gave mental torture and demanded dowry from the deceased and forced her to sell her property and when the deceased refused, all the accused abused her in filthy language and caused mental cruelty to the deceased and due to which, the deceased committed suicide.

4. Heard. As per the prosecution case, due to the mental torture and demanding of dowry by the accused, the deceased committed suicide. It is the main contention of the petitioner that, he and the deceased loved each other for 9 years and later they got married and while so, due to her mental illness, she frequently threaten the petitioner as if she commit suicide and on the date of alleged occurrence, when the petitioner went for work, the deceased committed suicide and the petitioner is the reason for her suicide and he will neither abscond nor tamper the witnesses and prays for grant of anticipatory bail to him. Per contra, the learned Public Prosecutor contended that, A-1 appeared for the RDO enquiry on 11-02-2026 and thereafter he absconded and did not appear for further enquiry and RDO enquiry is pending and strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. After considering all the above said aspects, considering the nature of offence, nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and stage of the investigation, **this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.**

Hence this petition is dismissed.
