The petitioners seek relaxation of the condition which is already imposed on them in **C.M.P.No.375/2026 dated 02-02-2026.**

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Selvi. K. Deepa**, Advocate for the petitioners / Accused and **Thiru. V. Ravichandran, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

**ORDER**

**Heard both side.**

The petitioners seek relaxation of the condition which is already imposed on him in **C.M.P.No.375/2026 dated 02-02-2026.**

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been complying the condition imposed on the petitioners in CMP No.375/2026 dated 02-02-2026 for the past 17 days and due to the genuine and unavoidable reasons to carry out their day-to-day activities, it has become extremely difficult to comply with the said condition imposed by this Court and prays to relax the condition.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that, while granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners, this Court imposed to comply the conditional signature for a period of 30 days and the petitioners have complied only for 17 days out of the total 30 days.

4. Though the petitioners filed the petition for the relaxation of the anticipatory bail conditions with regard to reporting requirement, but during the enquiry requests modification with regard to daily signing. Considering the fact that the petitioners have complied with the conditions for the past 17 days and due to the reported practical difficulties, this Court is inclined to modify the condition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The earlier direction to report daily is modified, and the petitioners are directed to report before the respondent police every Monday at 10.00 a.m for the remaining period to be complied.
