This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the
presence of **Tvl. B. Mohan, S.Sampath and S. Sathiyabalan**, Advocates for the
Petitioner/ A-1 and **Thiru.N. Manoj Kumar, Public Prosecutor**, represented for
State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments,
this Court pronounced the following:-

ORDER

Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks modification of the condition imposed on him in
C.M.P.No.1375/2020 dated 23-06-2020.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was previously granted bail by this Court on 23-06-2020 in CMP No.1375/2020. Now the petitioner requested to modify the specific bail conditions that were imposed when bail was originally granted in 2020. The petitioner is challenging two specific conditions imposed in the original bail order that is, providing blood surety and the mandatory surrender of the passport. The petitioner does not have passport and hence prays to delete the said condition and prays to modify the condition with regard to the blood surety and instead of production of blood surety, he may permit to produce normal surety. If the conditions are modified, he will neither abscond nor tamper with any evidence. The petitioner prays to modify the blood surety condition to the standard normal surety and to delete the passport surrender condition.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the plea, highlighting the gravity of the offenses and the provisions under the UAPA. However, the prosecution fairly concedes that the petitioner does not possess passport.

4. This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the materials available on record. It is a settled principle of law that bail conditions should not be oppressive, unperformable, or amount to an effective denial of bail. Directing an accused to surrender passport who is stated to have no passport, is an impossibility. Similarly, requiring blood surety can often result in prolonged incarceration despite the grant of bail.

5. In light of the aforesaid facts and the submission of the prosecution regarding the passport, this Court is inclined to modify the bail conditions.

6. Accordingly, this petition is **allowed**. The conditions imposed in the order dated 23-06-2020 in CMP No.1375/2020 are modified as follows:

(i) The condition No.(iii) directing the petitioner to surrender his passport is hereby deleted, as the petitioner possesses no passport. If the petitioner acquires passport in the future, he shall surrender it immediately to this Court.

(ii) The condition No.(i) directing the petitioner to produce one blood surety is modified as:

(i) The petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Principal District & Sessions Court, Coimbatore and the sureties shall produce solvency certificate which is issued by not below the rank of Thasildhar.

All other conditions imposed in the original bail order shall remain unaltered and the petitioner shall comply the same.
