These two petitions have been filed on behalf of the petitioners in the respective petitions to release them on bail u/s.483 of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tmt.P. Nandhini**, Advocate for the Petitioners in C.M.P.No.2174/2026 / A-1 &2 and of **Tvl.K.Karthikaivelan, B.Sivakumar, K.Sumithra and K.Nijantha**, Advocates for the petitioner in C.M.P.No.2208/2026 / A-3 and **Thiru. N. Manojkumar, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petitions submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

COMMON ORDER

Heard both side.

The petitioners in the respective petitions are the accused in Crime No.536/2026 of Sulur Police Station, for the alleged offence u/s.306 of BNS @

306, 317(4) of BNS, they have filed these two petitions separately, seeking grant of bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is working as Team Leader and Store Incharge of Lakshmi Life Science Private Limited. The said company is involved in importing and selling of CNC Machine Tools, line blank, Form tool, Insert etc., A-1 and A-2 are working in the defacto complainant company as Store Keeper. A-3 is doing scrap business. A-1 and A-2 consistently misappropriated 771 numbers of tools from the defacto complainant's company and A-3 received the said materials knowing well that they are theft properties. Hence, the present case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners in C.M.P.No.2174/2026 submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case and they never indulged in any such activities as alleged and they have been falsely implicated in this case and they are ready to abide any condition and they are in judicial custody for the past 22 days and prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner in C.M.P.No.2208/2026 submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged and he is the sole bread winner of his family and he is ready to abide any condition and he is in judicial custody for the past 23 days and prays to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that there are three accused in this case. **The petitioners in C.M.P.No.2174/2026 are arrayed as A-1 and A-2. The petitioner in C.M.P.No.2208/2026 is arrayed as A-3.** The defacto complainant is working as Team Leader and Store Incharge of Lakshmi Life Science Private Limited. The said company is involved in importing and selling of CNC Machine Tools, line blank, Form tool, Insert etc., A-1 and A-2 are working in the defacto complainant company as Store Keeper. A-3 is doing scrap business. A-1 and A-2 consistently misappropriated 771 numbers of tools from the defacto complainant's company and A-3 received the said materials knowing well that they are theft properties. After arrest, portion of properties are recovered. No previous case is reported against the petitioners in the respective petitions. Investigation is still going on.

6. After considering the submissions, considering the nature of offence, having regard to the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioners in the respective petitions, as portion of properties are recovered and no previous case is reported against the petitioners in the respective petitions, **this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners in the respective petitions subject to the following conditions:-**

(i) The petitioners in the respective petitions are ordered to be enlarged on bail on their executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Sulur.

(ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

(iii) The petitioners in the respective petitions are directed to sign before the respondent police, daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 15 days.

(iv) The petitioners in the respective petitions shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

(v) The petitioners in the respective petitions shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

(vi) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate / Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in the respective petitions in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners in the respective petitions released on bail by the learned Magistrate / Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji /vs/ State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**.

(vii) If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
