This petition has been filed through **e-Filing** on behalf of the petitioner to release her on anticipatory bail u/s.482 of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tvl. N. Deepak Prasanth, and E. Gokula Priya**, Advocates for the Petitioner / A-2 and **Thiru.N. Manojkumr, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

ORDER

Heard both sides.

The petitioner is the accused in Crime No.137/2026 of Kattur Police Station, since she is apprehending arrest in the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences u/s 318(4), 296(b), 115(2), 351(3) of BNS, she has filed this petition, seeking grant of anticipatory bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner's husband namely A-1 had already been enlarged on bail as the issue was settled between the parties.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objection in allowing this petition, considering the settlement between the parties.

4. This Court has considered the submissions made by both sides. On perusal, it is seen that an amicable settlement was arrived at between the parties as per the Mediation report dated 15-06-2026 and that A-1 was enlarged on bail. Given the resolution of the dispute between the parties and the lack of opposition from the Public Prosecutor, no fruitful purpose would be served by custodial interrogation of the petitioner, **hence this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:-**

(i) Anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner.

(ii) The petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- in the event of her arrest or the petitioner shall surrender before the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Coimbatore and execute a bond of Rs.10,000/- within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner shall stand automatically cancelled.

(iii) The petitioner shall produce two sureties for likesum each to the value of Rs.10,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Coimbatore within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner shall stand automatically cancelled.

(iv) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

(v) The petitioner is directed to sign before the respondent police, daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.

(vi) The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

(vii) The petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

(viii) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate / Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate / Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji /vs/ State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**.

(ix) If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
