Suit for declare that the 2nd defendant is not properly appointed trustee and is not a fit and proper person to hold the office of Managing Trustee of the Public

Charitable Trust G.V.Doraiswamy Naidu Charities; and grant an order of consequential permanent injunction restraining the 2nd defendant from officiating or acting as a Managing Trustee of G.V.Doraiswamy Naidu Charities; and declare that the Supplementary Deed of Trust dated 13-11-2013 is vitiated by fraud, null and void, contrary to the terms of the original deed of Trust dated 24-04-1970, and is liable to be set aside; and grant an order of consequential permanent injunction restraining the defendants 2 to 8 from officiating as Trustees of G.V.Doraiswamy Naidu charities; and declare that the 3rd defendant is incapable of holding office of Managing Trustee / Trustee of G.V.Doraiswamy Naidu Charities; and grant an order of consequential permanent injunction restraining the 3rd defendant from holding office of Managing Trustee / Trustee of G.V.Doraiswamy Naidu Charities; and grant an order of mandatory injunction directing appointment of one from amongst the plaintiffs as the Managing Trustee of the Trust and for reconstitution of the Trust Board by appointment of plaintiffs and other fit and proper persons to the office of Trusteeship.; and directing the defendants 2 to 8 to render a true and proper account of the Trust properties and income and proceeds of the Trust and for costs.

Date of suit 22-08-2022 and 24-08-2022.

Cause of action arose on 27-04-1970, 15-05-2004, 21-10-2006, 13-11-2013 and 2020 at Coimbatore.

The suit is filed in respect of a Public Charitable Trust and value of the suit in the estimation of the plaintiff is Rs.10,00,000/- for the purpose of jurisdiction. In terms of Section 28 of Tamil Nadu Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955, fee is computed on the maximum value of Rs.5000/- and Court fee of Rs.1000/- is paid on the plaint pursuant to Section 28 of the Tamil Nadu Court Fees and Suits valuation Act, 1955 as amended.

This suit is came up for final hearing before this Court on 28-04-2026, in the presence of *M/s. Ramani & Shankar* Advocates for the plaintiffs and of *Tvl.R. Venkatesan, M.Andanaraj, M.Aadarsh Raj*, Advocates for the defendants 1 to 3 and 6 to 8 and of *Thiru.M.Sundara Kadeswaran*, Advocate for the 4th respondent and 5th respondent having been reported dead and in view of the order passed in IA.8/2025, this Court doth order and decree as follows:-

1. that the suit be and the same is hereby dismissed as withdrawn, and
2. that there be no costs in this suit.
