This petition has been filed on 18.12.2025 and came for final hearing on 07.04.2026 in the presence of the complainant and upon perusal of the petition and connected records and on hearing enquiry, this court passed the following

Order

(1). Heard the complainant and perused the petition and connected records. On perusal of records, it reveals that the complainant herein has filed this petition under Section 172(3) of BNSS seeking direction to register FIR towards the complaint dated 02.04.2026.

(2).The Complainant submits that on that on 09.09.2025 the accused No. 1 & 2 abused the defacto complainant and also his wife and criminally intimidated them in a dire consequences. Hence, the complainant lodged complaint before the Inspector of Police, Sulur PS on 15.09.2025 and then before the Superintendent of Police and since they have failed to take action, the Complainant filed this petition.

(3). Heard and records perused. On perusal of records, it is clearly revealed that as per the Judgment of **Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in 2018 (2) Law Weekly (Crl.) 489 – G.Prabakaran /Vs/ The Superintendent of Police, Tanjore District**

and another, the complainant has complied the requirements of u/s.154(3) of Cr.P.C and also the complainant filed affidavit as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Srivastava Vs State of UP 2015 Vol.6 SCC 287*. Hence, this complaint is forwarded to Station House Officer, Sulur Police Station, Coimbatore District u/s.175(3) of BNSS (156(3) of Cr.P.C.). The Head Clerk of this Court is directed to send Original Complaint, Affidavit of the complainant, documents filed along with the complaint and Original Order of this court to the jurisdiction of Inspector of Police for enquiry and to submit report before this court.
