This case referred to the Lok Adalat organized by the District Legal Services Committee, Mettupalayam under Section 19/29(i) of the Legal Services Authorities Act (Act 39 of 1987) coming today before us for the endeavours' for settlement of the dispute between the parties, being the subject matter of this case in the presence of the parties and their counsel and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the cause, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be an award/order/decree in terms of settlement hereto made and the parties and their counsel herein having, in acceptance of the same, signed this in our presence, it is decreed/ordered.

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

"Both parties are present. On negotiation, both parties have agreed on the settlement of the dispute for a sum of Rs. 270000 /- (Rupees Two Lacs Seventy thousands only) Only towards full quit of the claim.

The 3rd respondent/s is/are directed to deposit the settled amount before the competent court within six weeks from the date of this award, failing which the respondent/s agreed to pay interest at 7. 5% per annum on the award amount from today till the date of deposit.

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with sections 21/22 E of the Legal Services Authorities Act 1987.

As and when the award amount is deposited in the court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner/s through NEFT/ RTGS, as per the directions of the High Court of Madras, in CMA No: 428 of 2016, in the bank account of the petitioner/s as given below:
