1. That the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is the insurer of the Vehicle does pay to the petitioners a sum, of /- (Rupees only) in full quit of the claim and that parties do bear their respective costs, being the insurer of the vehicle.

2. That the Petitioner is entitled to withdraw the full award amount.

3. The Petitioner is entitled to receive entire share award amount of Rs. 11,50,000 /- (Rupees only) without any deposit.

4. That the entire court fee paid by the petitioner shall be refunded to the petitioner.

5. The 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is directed to deposit the settled amount before the competent court within three months from the date of this award, failing which the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent agreed to pay interest per annum on the award amount from today till date of deposit.

6. That the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent shall sent the award amount to the Special Subordinate Judge Court, Mettupalayam.

7. That the entire court fees paid by the petitioner shall be refunded to the petitioner.

8. That the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent be and is here by granted 30 days time from this date for payment of the award amount mentioned in clause 1 supra in to the bank Account of this.....Court to Deal with MCOP Cases, Coimbatore in the state bank of India, Main Branch, Coimbatore in A/c..... IFSC Code..... which interest should be paid at the rate of 7.5% p.a from the date of Award till the date of deposit of award amount.

6. Further that the petitioner/petitioners is/are directed to furnish their proof of address, Name of Bank and its Branch with IFSC Code, Account Number by submitting the first page of the Bank pass book duly attested, PAN Card and Aadhaar Card.
