This case referred to the Lok Adalat organized by the District Legal Services Committee, Coimbatore under Section 19/29(i) of the Legal Services Authorities Act (Act 39 of 1987) coming today before us for the endeavours' for settlement of the dispute between the parties, being the subject matter of this case in the presence of the parties and their counsel and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the cause, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be an award/order/decree in terms of settlement hereto made and the parties and their counsel herein having, in acceptance of the same, signed this in our presence, it is decreed / ordered.

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

“Both parties are present. On negotiation, both parties have agreed for settlement of the dispute for a sum of Rs. 365000 (*Rupees Three lakh Sixty Five Thousand only*) towards full quit of the claim.

The 2nd respondent/s is/are directed to deposit the settled amount before the competent court within One Month from the date of this award, failing which the respondent/s agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award amount from today till the date of deposit.

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with the sections 21/22 E of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987. As and when the award amount is deposited in the court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner/s through NEFT/ RTGS, as per the directions of High Court of Madras, in CMA No: 428 of 2016, in the bank account of the petitioner/s as given below

The court fee paid shall be refunded to the parties in the manner prescribed under section 69 A of the Tamil Nadu Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955 (as amended by the Tamil Nadu Act 44 of 2007 with effect from 02/05/ 2008).
