This is a bail petition filed under Section 480 of BNSS for the offences U/Sec. 331(3), 331(4), 305(a) of BNS and coming before this court on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of learned Advocate Mr.T.Karthik, for the petitioner/accused, learned APP Grade – I Mr.Akbar Raja for the prosecution, after hearing petitioners side and on perusal of case documents, this court delivers the following:

ORDER

- 1) The Petitioner is the Accused, who filed this bail petition u/s.480 BNSS, was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 09.02.2026 for the alleged offences U/Sec. 331(3), 331(4), 305(a) of BNS.
- 2) The case of the prosecution was reiterated and it was claimed that the accused is a law abiding citizen and he was falsely implicated in the above case by the respondent

police and he is ready to obey any condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court as the above case is false case and he will neither abscond and nor tamper the witness and he is ready to furnish sufficient sureties to the satisfaction of this Court. Hence, it is prayed to grant bail to the accused.

3) Notice issued to learned A.P.P and the respondent police. Police reply received. The complainant police objected to the petition by stating that the case investigation is still pending, if he is released on bail he would tamper with the prosecution evidence, may not appear before the court during the trial. APP reply received. In the reply, he has investigation is pending and so he opposed.

4) Both sides heard and the case records perused. On perusal of records, it is found that the accused was arrested, remanded to judicial custody on 09.02.2026 and for the past 31 days he is under judicial custody for the offence 331(3), 331(4), 305(a) of BNS. A major portion of stolen property was recovered in this case. From the remand request, it is came to know that the Petitioner/Accused is having previous cases of similar nature and specific case numbers of more than 4 crime numbers registered against this petitioner/accused in various police stations were mentioned in the remand request. Considering that the accused is an habitual offender and he is under judicial custody for short duration in this case, in which period it is claimed that the investigation is still pending by the prosecution and so this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Finally this petition is dismissed.
