This petition is coming for hearing before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.L.Sathishkumar, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent and this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS for seeking bail.

Prosecution case is that the FIR was registered as against the Petitioner/Accused for the alleged offences punishable U/Ss.112(2), 123 and 275 of BNS R/w.24(1) of COTPA Act for the alleged occurrence on 21.03.2026 and the Petitioner/Accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 21.03.2026.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused contended that the Respondent Police have registered an FIR as against the Petitioner/Accused and he is an innocent and falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged in FIR. He further stated it is a false case. He is innocent and no way connected with the offence. No previous case is pending against him. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 17 days.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that the Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 17 days only. The Respondent Police seized 450 pouches, totally 5000 pockets of hans from him. The offence is grave in nature and the investigation has not yet been completed. The quantity is very high. Hence, he has serious objection to release the Petitioner/Accused on bail.

Heard both sides.

Considering the rival submissions of both sides and considering the strong objection of the learned Public Prosecutor and facts and circumstances of the case and considering that the offence is grave in nature and the quantity is very high and considering that the investigation has not yet been completed, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
