Order No. 15 dated 12.03.2025

Record is suo-moto placed before me today by the BC-I of this court and he draws my attention to the fact that the instant matter has been settled in mediation. He also submits that the intimation from District Legal Services Authority, South 24 – Parganas at Alipore in this regard, along with the annexures, has been received this day.

Hence, the instant record is taken up for perusal and passing necessary order.

Perusal of the record reveals that on the prayer of the contesting parties herein, this case was sent to the District Legal Services Authority, Alipore, South 24-Parganas, for settlement through Mediation on 20.01.2025. Thereafter, a report from the Ld. Mediator, namely, Advocate Biswadeb Chatterjee, along with a report/letter from the Ld. Secretary of District Legal Services Authority, South 24 – Parganas at Alipore, and other annexures, have been received by this court today. From the mediation report dated 12.02.2025, it transpires that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties of this case (i.e., the claimant and the contesting OP no.2/Insurance Company) through mediation, and such mediation was successful. It is also seen that the terms and conditions of settlement in such mediation proceedings are valid and proper and they are not illegal in the eyes of law. Be it mentioned here that the present case is running ex-parte against the OP no.1/owner.

In light of the aforesaid reasons and in view of the compromise arrived at between the contesting parties; and **the fact that report/letter dated 12.03.2025 received from the Ld. Secretary of District Legal Services Authority, South 24 – Parganas at Alipore portrays ‘successful mediation’**, I am of the opinion that the instant case should be disposed of on the said grounds. **The mediation report of the Ld. Mediator namely Advocate Biswadeb Chatterjee is thus accepted.**

Hence, it is

ORDERED

That the instant MAC case be and the same is disposed of in terms of the Mediation report dated 12.02.2025, containing the terms and conditions of settlement.

Let this fact be noted in all concerned registers, court’s diary, cause list and in the CIS as well.

Upload the order in CIS accordingly.
