This petition came on 13.03.2026 before me for final hearing in the presence of Thiru.K.Kodeeswaran, Advocate for the Petitioners and of Thiru.V.Sampathkumar, Advocate for the Respondents and upon hearing both side arguments and upon perusing the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

This petition is filed by the Petitioners U/s.24 of CPC seeking to pass an order to transfer the suit in O.S.No.42/2022 on the file of Additional District Munsif Court, Cuddalore which to be tried along with the suit in O.S.No.37/2022 pending before the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore jointly.

**2. The petition averments are as follows:**

The petitioners have filed the suit in O.S.No.42/2022 before the Additional District Munsif Court, Cuddalore for declaration that the petitioners are duly elected the managing trustee and trustees of the Cuddalore District Central Co-operative Bank Employees Union, Cuddalore and for permanent injunction restraining the respondents their men or agents from in any manner interfering with the petitioners' management of the trust and its properties and for mandatory injunction directing the respondents to hand over accounts pertaining to trust, its properties, rents, deposits to the petitioners as against the respondents and the same is pending. The 4th respondent has filed the suit in O.S.No.37/2022 before the Hon'ble Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore as against the petitioners to declare that the 4th respondent's trust is being represented by the present office bearers and for consequential injunction restraining the petitioners from interfering with the peaceful administration of the 4th respondent's trust by an order of permanent injunction and for mandatory injunction directing the Secretary Cuddalore and Villupuram District Central Co-operative Bank Employees, Co-operative Bank, Cuddalore to allow the 4th respondent's trust to operate the account which the 4th respondent's trust holds with the Secretary, Cuddalore and Villupuram District Central Co-operative Bank Employees, Co-operative Bank, Cuddalore in savings bank account No.10008 and for mandatory injunction directing the Branch Manager, Canara Bank, Thiruppapuliur Branch, Cuddalore to allow the 4th respondent's trust to operate the account which the 4th respondent's trust holds with the Branch Manager, Canara Bank, Thiruppapuliur Branch, Cuddalore in savings bank account NO.1250101033066 and the same is pending before the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore. The suit in O.S.No.42/2022 on the file of the Additional District Munsif Court, Cuddalore is connected with the suit in O.S.No.37/2022 pending before the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore. Moreover, the parties and the relief sought for in both

suits are one and the same. So, the both suits should be tried together in one court in order to come to a correct conclusion and to save the precious time and to get a fair and proper judgment. There will not be any legal implements in conducting both the suits in one court on transfer. Hence, the petitioners are coming forward with this transfer the petition to transfer the suit in O.S.No.42/2022 on the file of the Additional District Munsif Court, Cuddalore to the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore and tried along with the suit in O.S.No.37/2022 jointly. Hence, the petitioners pray to allow the petition as prayed for.

3. The Respondents Counsel reported that no counter.

4. No oral or documentary evidence adduced on the either side.

5. **The Point for consideration :**

1. *Whether the petition is to be allowed or not?*

**6. Point - 1 :-**

This petition is filed by the Petitioners U/s.24 of CPC seeking to pass an order to transfer the suit in O.s.No.42/2022 on the file of Additional District Munsif Court, Cuddalore which to be tried along with the suit in O.S.No.37/2022 pending before the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore jointly.

**7. Heard both side arguments. Perused the case records and case status in ecourt service.**

8. On perusal of the case records and case status in ecourt service they found that the parties and the relief sought for in both suits are one and the same and in the both suits, the trial has not yet commenced. There is no objection raised on the Respondents 1 to 4 and also reported that no counter. Under these circumstances, if the above said cases are tried in different courts, certainly it may be possible for conflicting of decisions. Hence, considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the parties and relief sought for in both suits are one and the

same and the trial has not yet commenced in both cases, this court decides that it is appropriate to try the above said cases jointly in the same court to avoid conflict of decision and multiplicity of proceedings. Hence, this court decides that the petition is found to be allowed. Thus, the point is answered accordingly.

9. In the result, the Additional District Munsif, Cuddalore is directed to transfer the suit in O.S.No.42/2022 to the file of the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore. The Principal District Munsif, Cuddalore is directed to receive the same and it is to be tried jointly along with the suit in O.S.No.37/2022 pending on the file of the Principal District Munsif Court, Cuddalore as per the circumstances warrants and to dispose the suits according to law and this petition is allowed accordingly. No costs.
