This application was filed by the learned counsel of the accused on 24.03.2026.

ORDER

- 1) The petitioner/accused, Sasikuamr, S/o. Annamalai was granted mandatory bail u/s. 167 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 ("Cr.P.C") by this Court vide Order dated 26.12.2025 in Crl.M.P.No.5403 of 2025. The petitioner states that he is sign before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 AM. The petitioner is obeying the condition till today. The petitioner is poor coolie and he is a only sole bread winner of his family. Hence accused side pray this court to relax the condition.
- 2) Prosecution side content that, petitioner accused herein since 07.03.2026 appearing before the respondent station and affix his signature and in the circumstance of the 3rd condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.5403/2025 fully relaxed he will be abscond and the case

could not be proceed in further where the investigation in this casse is still pending. Hence strongly Objected.

- 3) Heard both side. At the time of argument orally submitted that accused is poor collie family and he is sole bread winner of his family and he is obey the condition. Hence prey this court to modified the 3rd condtion imposed to the accused. Prosecution side strongly objected that, if modified the condition he may be abscond.
- 4) Considering the period of incarceration under gone by the accused so far and consider the family condition of the accused further observe the obey the condition by the accused till today without fail, this Court considers just to modify the condition No.3 imposed in Crl.M.P. No. 5403 of 2025 as follows:

1. The petitioner/accused shall appear and sign before the respondent Police station first day of every week at morning 10.30.A.M. Until further order.
