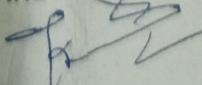
AWARD

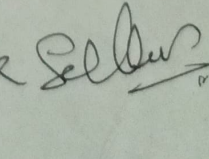

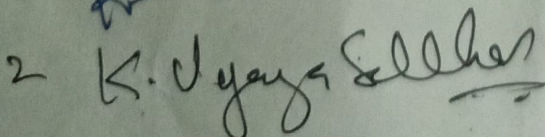
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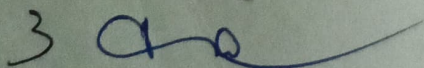
was solemnized on 23.12.2021 at IBTS temples of God Chruch Hall, Raghavendra Colony, Hyderabad as per Christian rites and caste customs and the marriage was consummated, however there are no issues. Later some disputes are cropped up in between them as per the advice of the elders; the complainant and respondents No:01 have entered into compromise in the presence of elders. The following are the terms and conditions of the compromise.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The 1st respondent has agreed to pay Rs.6, 50,000/- (Rupees Six lakhs Fifty Thousand only) towards full and final settlement (permanent alimony) of all claims of the complainant, including past, present and future maintenance and property claims against the respondents by the complainants in future. The complainant has agreed to receive the said amount. The Complainant received an amount of Rs.3, 51,400/- (Rupees Three lakhs Fifty One Thousand Four Hundred) from the 1st respondent today, by way of DD bearing No: 402398, drawn from State Bank of India, Tirupathi Branch on 28.06.2024 in favor of the Complainant, remaining amount of Rupees Two Lakhs Ninty Eight Thousand Six Hundred will be paid at the time of filing mutual consent Divorce OP with the 1st respondent failed to pay balance amount of Rs. (2,98,600/-) Rupees Two Lakhs Ninty Eight Thousand Six Hundred to the petitioner/ Complainant. The complainant /petitioner at liberty to file U/s. 498-A IPC and 420 cases against Respondents No: 1,2, and 3.
2. The complainant agreed to compromise in Criminal case lodged by the complainant against the respondents U/s.498-A and R/w. 34 IPC of IPC vide C.C.No.438/2022 on the file of Hon'ble On the file of Special Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Mobile) for Trial of Cases under PCR Act at Eluru-cum-III Addl Junior Civil Judge, Eluru, Eluru and co-operate for get acquittal and agreed to compromise the DVC No.69 of 2022 on the file of On the file of Special Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Mobile) for Trial of Cases under PCR Act at Eluru-cum-III Addl Junior Civil Judge, Eluru.
3. The complainant has agreed to cooperate with 1st respondent in taking divorce by way of mutual consent before the Hon'ble competent Court at Eluru.
4. The complainant and the 1st respondent are hereby agreed to not to file an Civil or Criminal cases against each other.
5. The both parties mutually agreed to patch up all the differences and today onwards there are no disputes between the both parties. The complainant has
