ORDER

1) Petitioners/Accused filed this petition seeking for Bail u/s. 480 of BNSS in Cr.No.22/2026, 296(b), 118(1), 351(3) BNS of Puthur P.S. Notice was given to the other side. Reply filed by Respondent police and APP. Heard both side arguments.

2) The Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that this is the 1st bail application filed for this petitioner. The petitioner is remanded on 23.03.2026 in this case and in judicial custody for past 14 days. The petitioner is innocent and has not committed any such offences alleged. The petitioner will not tamper the witnesses. The petitioner is law abiding citizen. Hence, considering all the above facts the petitioner/accused prayed that the bail petition may be allowed.

3) The prosecution strongly object to release the petitioner/accused on bail for the following reason, the investigation is pending. He will tamper the witnesses. He will flee from justice. He may repeat the offence and he will abscond. However stated that the injured had discharged from hospital.

4) This court has taken into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and gravity of offence, the number of days accused in judicial custody and stage of investigation and that injured had discharged from hospital. Hence in the interest of justice, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail on following conditions.

1. The petitioner/accused shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum each.
2. The petitioner/accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M. for 15 days.
3. Thereafter, the accused shall provide their residential address to the respondent police and in change of the residential address the same shall be intimated to the respondent police.
4. The accused shall not commit similar offences while in bail.
5. The accused shall co-operate with the respondent police, he shall not tamper the evidence, he shall not induce the witnesses and shall appear before this court on summons. If there is any violation or non-compliance of the conditions above, the investigation officer is within his discretion to approach this court for cancellation of bail order.
