ORDER:

SHO report received and perused. Arguments on application for superdari of vehicle bearing registration No.DL-1GE-1733 heard. As per the report of the SHO, he has no objection on releasing the said vehicle on superdari on the direction of the Court to the applicant. Accordingly, the vehicle in question bearing above-mentioned number be released on superdari in favour of its applicant on his furnishing superdignama in the sum of **Rs. 18,00,000/-** with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of SHO concerned with the condition that Superdar will not change the colour and shape of the vehicle and neither sell the vehicle till the pendency of the case and will produce the case property in court, as and when required. Further, the SHO has been directed to take photographs of the vehicle from all angles before releasing it on superdari and also duly ensure that the vehicle is released against proper receipt and verification, in pursuance of the directions in this regard issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Sunderbhai Ambalal v. State of Gujarat (2002) 10 SCC 283.** It is relevant to mention here that the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in **Manjit Singh Vs. State, decided on 10.09.2014 (Crl. M.C. No.4485/2016 and Crl. M.A. - 10- No.16055/2013)**, has also issued various direction to grant permission to release the vehicle on superdari. Hence in view of above, vehicle be released on superdari in favour of applicant on satisfaction of SHO concerned after furnishing superdginama in the sum of **Rs. 18,00,000/-** with one surety in the like amount on usual terms and conditions. Besides this, SHO/IO to comply the following directions:

- i. The IO/SHO shall prepare a detailed panchnama of the vehicle in question.
- ii. IO/SHO shall arrange to take Photographs of the vehicle from all the four angles including chassis number and engine number.
- iii. Further, the Photographs so taken are to be attested and countersigned by the IO, the applicant/complainant and accused.
- iv. IO/SHO shall retain the original RC and copy of insurance.

S.H.O./I.O. concerned is also directed to submit the panchnama and photographs in the court along with challan. Application in hand stands disposed of. Papers be tagged with FIR/main file.
