Ld. counsel for complainant has placed on record a
copy of order dated 24.01.2024 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi
whereby application filed by the accused for ad interim stay of
the present proceedings has been dismissed.

Ld. counsel for accused persons have acknowledged
and accepted the same without raising any objection regarding
the authenticity of the said order. Accordingly, copy of order
dated 24.01.2024 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi is taken on
record.

The accused persons are facing trial for the offence
punishable under section 500 r/w 34 of IPC. The offence is a
bailable offence. Accordingly, accused persons are admitted to
bail subject to furnishing of bail bond and surety bond in sum of

Rs. 25,000/- each. Bail bonds and surety bonds are furnished. Same are perused and accepted. Original RCs are taken on record. Necessary Robkar be issued.

Accused no. 1 is seeking permission to leave the Court as he has to attend an urgent meeting. He submits that he has no objection if the evidence of the complainant is recorded in his absence. Furthermore, he assures that he will not contest or dispute his identity during the recording of complainant's evidence.

In view of the submissions and considering that Ld. counsel for the accused no. 1 is present in the Court, accused no. 1 is granted permission to leave the Court. However, accused no. 1 shall remain bound by the undertaking given by him in the Court today.

Complainant is examined as CW-1 for about 1 hour 15 minutes and his cross examination is deferred as it is 3:45 PM and an application is moved by Ld. counsel for accused no. 1 to defer the cross examination of complainant until the examination of other witnesses of the complainant in the present case.

Copy of application is supplied to Ld. counsel for complainant.

Ld. counsel for complainant has opposed the application and submits on the next date of hearing, he will either file to the application or advance arguments on the same.

At this stage, Ld. counsel for accused no. 2 and 3 submits that he will also file similar application on behalf of the

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remaining accused persons. Heard. Let the application be filed positively on or before the next date of hearing and copy of the same be supplied in advance to the Ld. counsel for complainant.

Put up for reply, if any/arguments on the application filed by Ld. counsel for accused no. 1/CE on **08.02.2024 at 2:15 PM. Date and time is given at the convenience of Ld. Counsels for the parties.**
