

**::Order Below Withdrawal Pursis::
Read - Sec. 280 of BNSS**

- The complainant side of the matter has instituted the present **complaint U/Sec. 138** of The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, against the said accused side of the matter. However, during the proceedings of the matter, the parties to the it have come to the amicable settlement, since the accused of the matter has discharged the liability to the satisfaction of the complainant arising from the disputed instrument/s (cheque/s). Further, the complainant side has produced the withdrawal pursis. Thus, it appears appropriate for the Court to accept the present pursis.
- So far the question of imposing cost is concerned. Since, the matter is being withdrawn on the eve of national Lok Adalat. So, in the opinion of this Court, imposing cost on the eve of National Lok Adalat, may discourage the litigants from settling their matter on such occasions. Further, the occasion of Lok Adalat itself demands compassionate approach from this Court. Thus, in the opinion of this Court, the facts demand that, no cost shall be imposed upon the accused.
- Thus, this Court is inclined to pass below said final order in the present matter.

::Order::

- As per the withdrawal pursis given by the complainant side **matter is disposed off by settlement on the day of National Lok Adalat.**
- The complainant of the matter is hereby directed submit all the **original documents filed under documentary list immediately before this Court.**
