Inspector of Police, Mydukur U/G PS Vs Kamsala Suresh

Business : The accused 1 has filed a memo praying for permission to compound the offence. The complainant who is the Sub – Inspector of Police, Mydukur, PS filed memo through the learned Assistant public prosecutor reporting their readiness for compounding the offence as provided under law. Section 24 (1) of the Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 provides that any person who contravenes the provisions of section 6 shall be guilty of an offence under this Act and shall be punishable with fine which may extend to Rs. 200/- section 24 (2) of the said Act provides that all offences under this section shall be compoundable section 28 (1) of the said Act provides that any offence committed under section 6 may either before or after the institution of the prosecution be compounded by such offence authorized by central government or state government and for an amount which may not exceed Rs. 200/- section 28 (2) of the said Act provides that where an offence has been compounded under sub-section (1) in respect of an offender, if in custody shall be discharged and no further proceedings shall be taken against him in respect of such offence. In that view of the matter, the compromise as reported is accepted and the accused is permitted to compound the offence by paying the compounding fee of Rs. 200/- as provided under section 28 (1) of the said Act. The accused also filed a memo reporting that he does not require the unmarked case property i.e. CPR No. /20 which has been seized by the sub inspector of police, Mydukur PS reported no objection for the destruction of the same as the expiry date lapsed in that view of the matter, it is agreed by both parties that the said unmarked case property shall be destroyed forthwith and the accused acquitted under section 24 (1) of the Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulations of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and distribution) Act, 2003.

Accused paid compounding fee of Rs. 200/- .
