This petition for anticipatory bail coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.V.Babu, the learned counsel appearing for petitioner/accused, M/s.R.Thirumurugan, the learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following:

ORDER

The petition is filed by the petitioner/accused U/s.482 of B.N.S.S. to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

2. The petitioner/accused apprehends arrest at the hands of respondent police for the alleged offences U/s.316, 318 of BNS, 2023 in connection with the Cr. No. Not Known of 2026 of respondent Police Station.

3. Notice given to the Public Prosecutor for the State and the oral

reply submitted. Heard both sides. Records perused.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner/accused apprehends arrest at the hands of respondent police based on the false complaint lodged by the defacto complainant; however, the petitioner is no way connected with the offence as alleged; moreover, the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed upon him and he is ready to offer substantial sureties before the court thereby praying to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor, on the other hand, would submit that the complaint is pending for enquiry and till date neither a CSR nor a case has been registered against the petitioner.

6. It is submitted by the learned Public Prosecutor that till date no CSR or no case has been registered against the petitioner. Considering the above submissions, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner at this stage. Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
