This petition seeking relaxation of condition coming on this day for final hearing before me, M/s.J.William Shakesphere, the learned counsel appearing for petitioner/accused and M/s.R.Thirumurugan, the learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of the available records this Court delivered the following

O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused, U/s.483 of BNSS, 2023, praying to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner by this Court in Crl.M.P. No.485 of 2026 dated 19.02.2026.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this Court as per the order in Crl.M.P. No.485 of 2026 dated 19.02.2026 with a condition, *'to report before the respondent police station daily at 10.30 A.M. for 30 days'*. Further, the petitioner has complied with the condition for 17 days and since she facing difficulties, he

prayed to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner.

3. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner has complied with the condition for 15 days.

4. Heard both sides and records perused.

5. From the submissions, it is seen, the petitioner had complied with the condition for about 15 days. It is further seen the petitioner has a male child aged about 7 years, who suffered with Amniotic band syndrome (ABS), hence the petitioner facing difficulties. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner.

6. **In the result, this petition is allowed.** The condition imposed upon the petitioner in Crl.M.P. No.485 of 2026 dated 19.02.2026 is fully relaxed. The petitioner/accused is directed to appear before the concerned court on receipt of summons.
