This petition coming on today before me for hearing, M/s.K.Thenrajan, the learned counsel is appearing for the petitioner, upon perusal of records and hearing the petitioner's side and having stood over the matter for consideration till this day, this Court made the following

O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the petitioner, U/s.175(3) of BNSS, 2023, praying to please to issue direction to the 2nd respondent to register a FIR based on the petitioner's complaint dated 31.12.2025 and to take appropriate action against the accused in accordance with Law.

2. According to the petitioner, she belonged to SC/ST community. During the year 2007, she came into contact with the accused Suburaj, S/o. Paramasivam, later, during 2022, they met again and exchanged their phone numbers and started communicating frequently. Further, the accused expresses his love towards the petitioner and promised that he would marry me. Accordingly, the petitioner developed a relationship with him in good faith and trust.

3. Thereafter, the accused repeatedly informed her that he had taken loans for his house and car and requested financial help from her. Due to the promise of marriage and the threats made by the accused, the petitioner used to give money to him for about three years, to the total tune of approximately Rs.12,32,000/-. Apart from the above amount, the accused had received 2½ sovereigns of gold chains (3 chains) and one gold ring from the petitioner.

4. While so, on 10.07.2025, the petitioner met the accused in person and requested him to marry her as promised. At that time, the accused humiliated her and refused to marry her stating that she belonged to SC/St community and she is not from his caste. The accused openly admitted that he had staged a fake love relationship only to obtain money and gold from her. He also abused her with filthy language and threatened her that if she continued to contact him, he would morph her photographs and upload them on the internet to defame her.

5. On 27.08.2025, the petitioner, through WhatsApp status of the accused's relatives, the accused had married another woman from Thoothukudi District. On 11.09.2025 at about 09.45 A.M. the petitionr

contacted the accused over phone and asked him to return her money and gold jewels as he had cheated her. At that time, the accused criminally intimidated her and threatened that if she disturbed him again, he would kill her and harm her family members. The accused knowingly cheated her by giving a false promise of marriage, dishonestly obtained huge amounts of money and gold jewels from her and later refused to marry her on the ground that she belonged to a Scheduled Caste community, thereby humiliating her and exploiting her.

6. Thereafter, on 31.12.2025 before the 2nd respondent requesting to take action against the accused. However, no FIR has been registered, no proper action has been taken by the police. Later, on 21.01.2026, she send a representation to the 1st respondent, even thereafter, no action has been taken to register the case. Hence, the petitioner filed the present petition seeking a direction to the 2nd respondent to register an FIR and conduct a proper investigation against the accused based on her complaint dated 31.12.2025.

7. Heard the petitioner's side; records perused.

8. **In the result, the Complaint dated 31.12.2025 is ordered to be forwarded to the Inspector of Police, Pallavaram Police Station, with a direction to register a FIR based on the complaint and to proceed in accordance with law.**
