This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before me, in the presence of M/s.J.Dilliraj, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners/accused, and M/s.R.Thirumurugan, the learned Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both side arguments and upon perusal of case records this Court made the following

**O R D E R**

This petition has been filed by the petitioners/accused seeking extension of time for two weeks to surrender and furnish the sureties before the Court below as per the Order of this Court in Crl.M.P. No.1318 of 2026 dated 30.04.2026.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.M.P. No.1318 of 2026 dated 30.04.2026 with a condition to surrender before the learned District Munsif

cum Judicial Magistrate, Cheyyur within 15 days. Further, due to the illness of the petitioners, they could not able to surrender before the Court below and also furnish the sureties within the stipulated period, hence prays to grant extension of time for two weeks to comply with the condition imposed by this Court.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objection.

4. Heard and records perused.

5. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, facts and circumstances of the case and also in the interest of justice, this Court is inclined to allow this petition.

**6. In the result, this petition is allowed. On deposit of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) by each of the petitioners before the Mediation Centre, Chengalpattu,** further two weeks time from today is granted to the petitioners, to surrender before the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Cheyyur and furnish sureties as directed by this Court in CrI.M.P. No.1318 of 2026 dated 30.04.2026. The other conditions imposed upon the petitioners/accused by this Court Shall remain unchanged.
