This petition for anticipatory bail coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.M.Kannan, the learned counsel is appearing for petitioner/accused, M/s.V.Krishnamoorthy, the learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following:

O R D E R

This petition is filed U/s.482 of B.N.S.S. to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest at the hands of respondent police for the alleged offences U/s.296(b), 118(1) of BNS, 2023, in connection with Cr. No.Not Known of respondent police station.

3. Notice given to the Public Prosecutor for the State and reply received. Heard both sides; records perused.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner/accused is innocent person, he has no way connected with the said offence; moreover, the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed upon him and he is ready to offer substantial sureties before the court and prayed for enlargement on anticipatory bail.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor, on the other hand, would submit that a case has been registered in Cr. No.365 of 2026 for the offences U/s.296(b) and 351(2) of BNS, 2023 and further submits that all the offences are bailable in nature.

6. It is seen the offences under which the present FIR has been registered all are bailable in nature. Under such circumstances, this court is of the considered view that this petition becomes infructuous. Hence, this court is not inclined to entertain this petition. **Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.**
