This petition for bail coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.E.Surya Prabakaran, the learned counsel is appearing for the petitioner/accused and of M/s.V.Krishnamoorthy, the learned Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS 2023, seeking to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

2. The petitioner/accused is facing charges for the alleged offences U/s.309(6), 311 of BNS, 2023.

3. Notice given to the Public Prosecutor for the State and reply received. Heard both sides; records perused.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner is falsely implicated in this case; he was arrested and remanded on 02.07.2026; he is under judicial custody for the past 27 days; the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed upon him and is ready to offer substantial sureties before the Court, thereby praying for enlargement on bail.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor, on the other hand, would submit that the defacto complainant is a college student, native of Kerala. On 02.07.2026, at about 5:15 p.m., the petitioner along with other accused have called the defacto complainant to a secluded place, where the accused persons demanded money from him. Since he refused, the accused persons abused him with filthy words, tried to attack him with knife, extorted a sum of Rs.2000/- from him at knife point and also threatened him with dire consequences and prays for the dismissal of the petition.

6. Cursory perusal of records would go to show that the occurrence has taken place on 02.07.2026 and the accused is in custody from the same day. Total number of days in custody exceeds 26 days. It is seen substantial portion of investigation has been completed. Since the petitioners has permanent residence within the jurisdiction of the respondent police, there is no possibility of flee from justice. Taking into consideration the duration of custody, nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner, stage of investigation, the petitioner seemed to be the first offender, no previous case is pending against him and also considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. In the result, the petition is allowed; The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his execution of bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Chengalpattu, with further conditions that;

1. The sureties shall affix his photographs and Left Thumb Impression (LTI) in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce copy of any identity proof before the learned Magistrate to ensure his identity;
2. The petitioner/accused is directed to report respondent Police Station daily at 10.30 A.M. for a period of 30 days;
3. The petitioner/accused shall not abscond or tamper with the evidence either during investigation or trial;
4. If there is any breach of conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate and the learned Magistrate shall take appropriate action as if the conditions have been imposed by the Magistrate himself/herself in accordance with the decision in *AIR 2006 SC 100 - P.K. Shaji Vs State of Kerala*.
