This petition for bail coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.J.Dilliraj, the learned counsel is appearing for petitioner/accused, and of M/s.V.Krishnamoorthy, the learned Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing the arguments and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following

**ORDER**

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused U/s.483 of BNSS, 2023, praying to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner in Crl.M.P. No.1671 of 2026 dated 09.06.2026.

2. The learned counsel who is appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this court as per the order in Crl.M.P. No.1671 of 2026 dated 09.06.2026, with a condition to “*directed to report before the respondent police station daily at 10.30 A.M. for 30 days*”. He

further submitted that the Petitioner has complied the condition for 23 days without any default and he is facing difficulties in complying the condition and hence he prays to relax the condition imposed upon him.

3. On the other hand the learned Public Prosecutor admit that the petitioner had complied with the condition for 23 days.

4. Heard both sides and records perused.

5. Taking into consideration of the representations made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Petitioner has complied with the condition for 23 days and also considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to relax the condition imposed on the Petitioner.

6. **In the result, this petition is allowed.** The condition imposed upon the petitioner in Crl.M.P. No.1671 of 2026 dated 09.06.2026 is totally relaxed. The petitioner/accused is directed to appear before the court on receipt of summons.
