This petition seeking relaxation of condition coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.S.Mathivanan, the learned counsel is appearing for the petitioner/accused and of M/s.D.R.Manmathan, the learned Special Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused, U/s.483 of BNSS, 2023, praying to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner by this Court vide order in Crl.M.P. No.1972 of 2026 dated 15.06.2026.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this Court as per the order in Crl.M.P. No.1972 of 2026 dated 15.06.2026 with a condition, *'to report before the respondent police station daily at 10.30 A.M. for 30 days'*. The petitioner has complied with

the condition for about 24 days and since he facing difficulties, he prayed to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner.

3. The learned Special Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner had complied the condition for 24 days.

4. Heard both sides and records perused.

5. From the submissions, it is seen the petitioner had complied with the condition for 24 days. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed upon the petitioner.

6. **In the result, this petition is allowed.** The condition imposed upon the petitioner in Crl.M.P. No.1972 of 2026 dated 15.06.2026 is fully relaxed. The petitioner/accused is directed to appear before the concerned court on receipt of summons.
