This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before me, in the presence of M/s.A.R.Janarthanan, the learned counsel is appearing for the petitioners/accused, and M/s.V.Krishnamoorthy, the learned Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioners/accused seeking extension of two weeks time to surrender and furnish the sureties before the Court below as per the Order of this Court in Crl.M.P. No.1727 of 2026 dated 16.06.2026.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.M.P. No.1727 of 2026 dated 16.06.2026 with a condition to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Chengalpattu within 15 days and to furnish sureties. The petitioners were unable to arrange the sureties and hence they could not be

able to surrender before the court below and furnish the sureties within the stipulated period, hence prays to grant further two weeks time to comply with the condition imposed by this Court.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objection.

4. Heard and records perused.

5. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners, facts and circumstances of the case and also in the interest of justice, this Court is inclined to allow this petition.

6. In the result, this petition is allowed. On deposit of Rs.500/- each (Rupees Five hundred each only) by the petitioners/accused before the Mediation Centre, Chengalpattu, further two weeks time from today is granted to the petitioner, to surrender before the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Chengalpattu and to furnish sureties as directed by this Court in CrI.M.P. No.1727 of 2026 dated 16.06.2026. The other conditions imposed upon the petitioners/accused by this Court shall remain unchanged.
