This petition for bail coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.K.Duraimurugan, the learned counsel is appearing for the petitioner/accused and of M/s.V.Krishnamoorthy, the learned Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS 2023, praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

2. The petitioner/accused is facing charges for the alleged offences U/s.296(b), 126(2), 118(1), 109, 351(3) of BNS, 2023.

3. Notice given to the Public Prosecutor for the State and reply received. Heard both sides; records perused.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner; he was arrested and remanded on 11.07.2026 and he is under judicial custody for the past 17 days; the injured person has been discharged from the hospital; the co-accused has

been granted bail by this court in CrI.M.P. No.2251 of 2026; moreover, the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed upon him and he is ready to offer substantial sureties before the court, thereby praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor, on the other hand, would submit that due to prior enmity, on 27.06.2026 at night hours, while the defacto complainant consuming liquors, the accused persons came there, abused him with filthy words, assaulted him with knife and caused injuries, threatened him with dire consequences. He further submitted that though the injured person has been discharged from hospital, the victim sustained grievous injuries and further, the petitioner is involved in one another previous case and prays for the dismissal of the petition.

6. It is alleged that, due to prior enmity, the petitioner along with other accused have abused and assaulted the defacto complainant with knife thereby caused injuries. It is submitted that though the injured person has been discharged from the hospital, the victim sustained grievous injuries. It is further contended by the learned Pudblic Prosecutor that the petitioner is involved in yet another previous case. Taking into consideration the gravity of the offence, nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner and his previous antecedent, nature of injuries sustained by the victim and also considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with conditions. **Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.**
