This petition for bail coming on this day for hearing before me, M/s.K.Krishnasamy, the learned counsel is appearing for the petitioner/accused and of M/s.V.Krishnamoorthy, the learned Public Prosecutor is appearing for the respondent/complainant, upon hearing both sides and upon perusal of case records, this Court made the following

O R D E R

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS 2023, praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

2. The petitioner/accused is facing charges for the alleged offences U/s.125, 126(2), 296(b), 309(4), 311, 324(4), 351(3) of BNS, 2023.

3. Notice given to the Public Prosecutor for the State and the reply received. Heard both sides; records perused.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that

the petitioner is falsely implicated in this case; he was arrested and remanded on 19.06.2026; the earlier bail application was dismissed by this court in CrI.M.P. No.2111 of 2026 dated 09.07.2026; now the petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 39 days; moreover, the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed upon him and he is ready to offer substantial sureties before the Court, thereby praying for enlargement on bail.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor, on the other hand, would submit that the petitioner along with other accused have waylaid the defacto complainant and demanded money. Since he refused, the accused persons abused him with filthy words, beaten him, extorted a sum of Rs.1,500/- and his cellphone at knife point and also threatened him with dire consequences. Further, the petitioner is involved in two other previous cases and prays for the dismissal of the petition.

6. From the perusal of records, it appears that the occurrence has taken place 19.06.2026 and the petitioner is in custody from the same day. Total period of custody exceeds 39 days. It is seen substantial portion of investigation has been completed. The petitioner has permanent residence within the limit of respondent police, therefore, there is no possibility of flee from justice. Taking into consideration the duration of custody, nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner, stage of investigation and also considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. In the result, this petition is allowed; The petitioner/accused is ordered to be released on bail on his execution of bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial

Magistrate No.II, Chengalpattu, with further conditions that;

1. The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression (LTI) in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce any one of identity proof before the learned Magistrate to ensure their identity.
2. The petitioner/accused is directed to report before the respondent police station daily at 10.30 A.M. and 05.30 P.M. for 30 days;
3. The petitioner/accused shall not tamper the evidence either during investigation or trial;
4. The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;
5. If there is any breach of conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate and the learned Magistrate shall take appropriate action as if the conditions have been imposed by the Magistrate himself/herself in accordance with the decision in *AIR 2006 SC 100 - P.K. Shaji Vs State of Kerala*.
