ORDER

1) The petitioner has filed this petition U/s. 497 and 503 of BNSS., seeking for interim custody of Hero Splendor Plus Drum Motor Cycle Bearing No.TN-19-K-4618, Engine No.HA10EJDHE37273,Chassis No.MBLHA10ALDHE25878.

2) The petitioner in his petition had contented that the is the owner of the property. If the vehicle is kept in open air sun and rain, its value will get deteriorated. On the said grounds, the petitioner prayed for custody of the vehicle. The petitioner further contended that he had purchased the above vehicle from one Mr.S.Selvaraj, S/o.Somasundram in the month of 14th July 2024 and that he had signed the TO form. The petitioner could not be able to transfer the name of the vehicle due to financial constraint. The petitioner stated that the Registration Certificate of the above said vehicle is under his custody and stated that he will transfer the name of the owner

as soon as the vehicle was released. And prayed to allow this petition.

3) Records perused.

4) On perusal of records it is seen from the R.C. Book that the Two wheeler does not stands in the name of petitioner. The case is already disposed off. In the property order dated 19.01.2026 this court had ordered to return the vehicle to owner. The TO Forms shows prima facie for the ownership claimed by the petitioner. Hence this court orders to return the property to the petitioner on condition that the petitioner shall change the ownership of case property in his name and the records for the same shall be produced before this court within 30 days.

5) Accordingly with above condition this petition is allowed.
