Matter take up on application u/s 483 BNSS moved on behalf of the applicant/ accused Sunil Kumar @ Luna seeking regular bail.

1. This is an application u/s 483 BNSS moved on behalf of the applicant/ accused **Sunil Kumar @ Nuru** seeking **regular bail**.
2. Reply has been filed by the IO. Same is taken on record.
3. Arguments heard. Record perused. Ld. Counsel for the applicants/accused seeks bail for the applicants/accused on the following grounds :- (i) The applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case; (ii) Chargesheet has already been filed; (iii) victim/ injured has already been examined; and (iv) The applicants/accused are in JC since 07.04.2024; it will take considerably long time to conclude the trial and he cannot be kept in JC for an indefinite period.
4. Ld. Sub. Addl. PP for the State has strongly opposed the present applications and has prayed for their dismissal.
5. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused, Ld. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record. The victim/ injured has already been examined as PW-1. The applicant/accused is in JC since 07.04.2024. Conclusion of the trial is likely to consume considerable time. Hence, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind bars. Accordingly, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, **applicants/accused Karan and Himanshu are admitted to regular bail** on furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) each with one surety each of the like amount** to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court

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concerned/Ld. JMFC/ Ld. Duty JMFC, subject to the following terms and conditions :- (i) During the period of bail, the accused shall not try to contact directly or indirectly or through any of the electronic mode to the victim/complainant and family members of the victim/complainant or any public witness; (ii) During the pendency of the trial of this case FIR, the accused shall not get themselves involved in the similar nature of offence; and (iii) During the period of bail, the accused shall furnish their mobile numbers to the concerned IO/SHO and shall keep their mobile phones on for 24 X 7 and will respond as and when called by the concerned IO/SHO.

6. A copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. Counsel for the accused and to the IO and be also sent to the Superintendent Jail concerned for information.

7. Put up for the above purpose on **08.08.2025**.
