ORDER

1. The Application is filed seeking the relief of Relaxation Petition.

2. Brief averment of the Petition:

The Petitioner/accused has moved the bail petition before this court and this court has enlarged bail to the petitioner with the condition to put signature before the Respondent Police daily at 10.30 AM, for 30 days. The condition may be relaxed to put signature at Respondent Police Station. Hence, the condition imposed is to be relaxed. Hence, this Petition.

3. Point for determination:

Whether the Bail Application can be allowed or not?

4. Discussion:

Heard. Records perused. On perusal of records, it reveals that the Petitioner/

accused person namely Bharath @ Kari Bharath, aged about 28 years, s/o. Moorthy was enlarged on bail on 10.07.2026 in Cr.No.463/2025. Further, it reveals that the final report has been filed and it has been taken on file and numbered as PRC.No. 79/2026. Reasons are satisfied. Since, investigation is completed and on considering the age of the accused. Hence, on considering above and in the interest of justice, the condition that is the Petitioner is directed to appear before the Respondent Police for 30 days at 10.30 AM is totally relaxed and other condition remain the same, this Petition is allowed.

5. In the result, the Petition is allowed.
