J U D G M E N T

The Sub-Inspector of Police, Kolluru P.S. filed charge sheet against accused in Cr.No.102/2022 for the offence under Sec.323 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Prosecution filed memo to advance matter and same is recorded and advanced the matter to this date.

Accused 1 to 6 are present and copies of documents furnished to them.

Accused were examined under section 251 Cr.P.C., accusation levelled against him for the offence punishable under section 323 r/w34 IPC is read over and explained to them in Telugu language, for which, they pleaded guilty. Accused 1 to 6 admitted the offence punishable U/sec.323 r/w 34 IPC and their admission appears voluntarily. Accused 1 to 6 convicted U/sec.252 of Cr.P.C and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- by each accused for the offence punishable U/sec.323 r/w 34 of IPC, in default of payment of fine, they shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one week. The total fine amount is of Rs.6,000/-(Rupees Six thousand only).
