This case coming on 12-11-2022 for final disposal and the matter having been stood over for consideration to this day, this court delivered the following:—

// JUDGMENT //

Summons of accused served. The accused 1 and 2 are present. Copies furnished U-s.207 Cr.P.C. The accused are examined U-Sec.251 Cr.P.C. for the offence U/Sec. 20 (2) of COTP Act and the accused are pleaded guilty of the offence voluntarily this court has accepted the plea of accused as true and voluntarily, therefore this court opined the accused 1 and 2 are found guilty of the offence U-Sec. 20 (2) of COTP Act and convicted them U-Sec.252 Cr.P.C. When the accused are questioned with regard to sentence imposed on them, they pleaded mercy. The offence U-Sec.20 (2) of COTP Act is punishable with imprisonment for one year or fine. In the circumstances of the case this court is inclined to sentence the accused by imposing fine only.

Accordingly, A1 and A2 are sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,000-00 each for the offence punishable under section 20 (2) of COTP Act, IDSI to suffer SI for Fifteen days Total fine amount of Rs.2,000/-.

The Unmarked Non Valuable case property in the custody of S.H.O, Podili is ordered to be destroyed and also directed to the S.H.O to file the description proceedings.
