It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the sureties that applicants / sureties Sh. Amit Singh and Sh. Ashok had stood surety to accused Madhusudhan. It is further submitted that at the time of granting the interim bail of the accused Madhusudhan, applicant Sh. Ashok had produce the original R/C of vehicle bearing registration no. DL-8SBT-5894 and Sh. Amit Singh had produce FDR and the same are lying in the judicial file. It is further submitted that accused Madhusudhan has already surrendered before the jail authorities. In view of the same, no useful purpose shall be served by keeping the RC and FDR of above-named sureties on record. Therefore, it is prayed that the present application may kindly be allowed.

Perusal of the record shows that accused Madhusudhan has already surrendered before the jail authorities. Accordingly, no purpose shall be served by keeping the aforementioned documents on judicial record.

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Accordingly, let the original RC of vehicle bearing registration no. DL-8SBT-5894 of applicant Sh. Ashok Kumar and FDR of applicant Sh. Amit Singh be released to them against due acknowledgment as per law. One signed copy of the same be retained on record.

Application is disposed off, accordingly.
