e-Petition filed u/s. 482 B.N.S.S. dated 13.07.2026 to release the accused on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest.

This petition is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.J.Gopinath, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.C.Ramalingam, Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Crime Branch, Villupuram for the state, and upon perusing both side contentions, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

This **e-petition** has been filed by the petitioner u/s.482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking Anticipatory Bail for the offences alleged to have been committed by him under section 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner stated that the Petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this offence and he would neither abscond nor tamper any witnesses and he is ready to abide any condition to be imposed by this court. He is apprehending arrest in the hands of the Respondent and prays to release him on Anticipatory bail.

The Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Crime Branch, Villupuram represented that the incident said to have taken place on 15.05.2026 and FIR was registered on 19.05.2026 Only one accused involved in this case. Due to land dispute between the parties, on the occurrence day, the petitioner abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and attacked him with spade on his head. Further stated that the injured person has been treated only as out patient.

Considered the submissions on both sides and the records. It is alleged that due to land dispute, the petitioner attacked the complainant with spade. It is stated that the injured person has been treated only as out patient. The occurrence happened was on 15.05.2026. Considering these

aspects and the nature of the offence, this court is inclined to grant Anticipatory Bail to the Petitioner with the following conditions:-

In the result, the Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of his arrest by the Respondent police or in the event of his surrender before the concerned Judicial Magistrate **within a period of two weeks from the date of this order** on his executing a bond for **Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of **Judicial Magistrate No.II, Tindivanam** and on further condition that **the Petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 A.M., for a period of 2 weeks** (including holidays) from the next day of execution of bond before the Trial Court and on further conditions that,

- (a) the Petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;
- (b) the Petitioner shall not commit any offences of similar nature;
- (c) the Petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial,
- (d) the Petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial,
- (e) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial court himself/herself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
- (f) If the Accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under section 269 of B.N.S.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.
