I.O. of this case has arrested and forwarded the FIR named accused persons
1. Shivji Sahni, aged about 76 years, S/o- Mauje Sahni, Vill- Sauli Math, P.S.- Tariyani Chhapra, 2. Chunnu Rai, aged about 28 years, S/o- Vishal Rai, Vill- Belsand, W.N.-02, P.S.- Belsand, and 3. Sanjay Krishan Jha, aged about 40 years, S/o- Shobhakant Jha, Vill- Laxmipur, P.S.- Belsand, all Dist- Sitamarhi under Police escort party along with forwarding report and memo of arrest. The said accused persons do not complain for any type of misbehave towards police escort party. The said accused persons do not claim for free legal assistance. The family member of the said accused persons have already been informed. No external physical injury found on their body. The I.O. has submitted form VI as per Rule 18 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Rules 2022.

On perusal of F. I. R, Form VI, breathe analyser report (BAC) and other material available on record that a prima facie case U/s 37 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Rules act 2016 is made out against the aforesaid accused persons and accordingly cognizance is taken.

The accusation is explained to the accused persons to which they plead guilty. The deposition of the accused persons have also been recorded in form VI-A as per Bihar Prohibition and Excise Rules 2022. They further says that it is their first offence.

Having considered aforesaid including the fact that the accused persons have pleaded they guilt voluntarily and also stated that it is their first offence for consuming the liquor U/s 37 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Rules act 2016 and they would not repeat said offence in future and there is nothing in the record to show that the accused persons were earlier convicted for the offence U/s 37 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Rules act 2016, the accused persons are convicted and sentenced to deposit penalty of Rs-2000/- each and on default of payment of said penalty they will undergo simple imprisonment for 30 days.

Let the accused persons be released after depositing said penalty or on fail be sent to the jail for sentence on default.
