Hence following;

ORDER

Acting under Section 253 of Cr.P.C., the accused is convicted for offence punishable under Section 27(b) of NDPS Act.

Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.300/- for contravention of offence under Section 27(b) of NDPS Act. In default to pay fine, he shall undergo S.I. for a period of one month.
