1] This is an application filed by the applicant to release him on regular bail in crime No.199/2026 registered with Shivajinagar Beed Police Station for the offence punishable under section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988

2] Applicant/accused submitted that informant has lodged report against him. After the report raid was conducted. He was arrested while accepting amount of Rs.3,000/-. Most of investigation is completed. Nothing is remained to be recovered or discovered from this applicant. Since 13.06.2026 he is in MCR. He has not committed any offence. All the documents are in the custody of the government office. He is ready to furnish surety. He is ready to abide all the terms and conditions. Therefore, prayed to grant bail.

3] APP has filed say and submitted that there is prima facie case against the applicant. There is active participation of this applicant. If he is released on bail, he will pressurize the complainant. He will commit such type of offence. Therefore, prayed to reject the application.

4] Heard the Ld. advocate for the applicant and Ld. APP for the State.

5] I have perused the record then it is gathered that most of investigation is completed during the conduct of the raid. Documentary evidence is in custody of government office. Nothing is remained to be recovered or discovered from this applicant therefore, further custodial interrogation is not necessary. Therefore, bail can be granted by imposing the terms and conditions. Hence, following order.

ORDER

1] Applicant/accused **Annasaheb s/o. Gabru Rathod** in crime No.199/2026, registered with police station Shivajinagar Beed, Dist. Beed, for the offence punishable under section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty Thousand Rupees only) with one or two sureties in the like amount.

2] The applicant shall report to the investigating officer as and when required.

3] The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence or attempt to influence or contact the complainant, witnesses or any person concerned with the case in any manner.

4] The applicant shall keep the Investigating Officer informed of his current address and mobile contact numbers, and/or change of residence or mobile details, if any, from time to time.

5] Bail before concerned Court.

6] The application stands disposed of.
