**Claim petition under section 166 of  
the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.**

**AWARD:**

Above named petitioners have filed the instant claim petition under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') for the grant of compensation on account of death of Kamlesh caused, in a roadside vehicular accident, which took place on 13.08.2025 on account of rash and negligent driving of offending vehicle no. RJ-21GA-6076, being driven by respondent no.1.

2. Today the matter has been taken up in Pre Lok Adalat. Compromise has been effected between the parties. Accordingly, the counsel for petitioners and counsel for respondent no.3-insurance company have suffered their joint statement to the effect that an award of Rs.13,50,000/- (Thirteen lacs and fifty thousand only) may be passed in favour of petitioners and against No.3 (Insurance Company) and in case respondent No.3-insurance company fails to pay/deposit the said amount within two months the petitioners shall also be entitled to claim interest @ 7.5% per annum on

awarded amount from the date of award till its realization.

3. So, in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the petition in hand stands partly allowed with no order as to costs. Resultantly, an award in the sum of Rs.13,50,000/- (Thirteen lacs and fifty thousand only) is hereby passed in favour of the petitioners. It is further ordered that the respondent No.3-Insurance company would pay the awarded amount in favour of petitioners in the form of cheque within a period of two months from today as agreed, failing which the petitioners shall be entitled to claim interest @ 7.5% per annum on the awarded amount from the date of filing of the petition till its actual realization.

4. The awarded amount Rs.13,50,000/- (Thirteen lacs and fifty thousand only) shall be disbursed in the following manner:
