nature. Hence, the compromise is recorded.

In the result, the Accused are acquitted U/S.320(8) Cr.P.C. for the offence U/Secs.420,
323, 506, 509 r/w 34 of IPC. Accordingly, the award is passed.

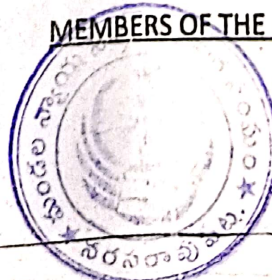
