... **Accused No.1 to 7**

This case coming for hearing before me in the presence of learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the state and upon perusing the material available on record, and having stood over till this day for consideration, this Court delivered the following :

O R D E R

State, represented by Sub-Inspector of Police, Cherukupalli Police Station has filed this case against the above accused no.1 to 7 in Crime No.44 of 2022 of Cherukupalli Police Station for the offence under sections 498-A, 307, 506, 509, 120(B) r/w.109 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. The contents of charge sheet in nutsheell is that:

The Complainant Shaik Shabnam Jani married accused no.1 Shaik Karimulla of Kanagala village on 28.04.2019. The accused no.1 is working in Indian Army and at that time of the complainant gave Rs.2,00,000/- cash, Ac.02:00 cents of land, Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) for motorcycle and 25 sovereigns of gold as dowry. After the marriage, the accused no.1 with the instigation of accused no.2 to 6 started harassing the complainant both physically and mentally for additional dowry of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) from her parents. On 30/11/2021 when the complainant and accused no.1 were at Army quarters at Madhura, accused no.1 mixed rat poison paste in dosa and made her to eat forcibly in order to kill her and she as admitted tin Military hospital. The accused no.1 to 7 abused her and threatened her with dire consequences and necked her out from their house. On coming to know that accused no.1 registered his property in the name of other accused, she went to the house of her husband and when she asked them, then accused no.2 caught her hands, accused no.5 poured petrol on her and when accused no.4 tried to lit match stick, the complainant escaped from there. Thus a prima-facie case was made out against the accused no.1 to 7 under sections 498-A, 307, 506, 509, 120(B) r/w.109 of Indian Penal Code and section 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. This case was taken on file against the accused no.1 to 7 for the offence under sections 498-A, 307, 506, 509, 120(B) r/w.109 of Indian Penal Code and section 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. Accused No.1, 3, 4 and 6 remanded to Judicial custody on 30/03/2022. Section 41(A) Cr.P.C. notices served on accused no.2, 5 and 7. The offence alleged against the accused no.1 to 7 under section 307 of Indian Penal Code is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions.

Therefore, the case is committed to the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Guntur, for trial U/Sec.209(a) Cr.P.C.

4. Accused No.3 got bail as per the orders of Hon'ble XI Addl. District & Sessions Judge's Court, Tenali in CrI. MP No.253/2022 dt.06/05/2022 and accused no.3 was released on bail on 07/05/2022. On 26/05/2022 the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh granted bail to Accused no.1, 4 and 6 and they were released on 30/05/2022 and they ordered to be continued on bail during and until the conclusion of Trial by the sessions Court U/Sec.209 (b) Cr.P.C.

5. Accused no.1 to 7 submitted that they have sufficient means to engage a counsel at Sessions Court for conducting trial. Further the accused were directed to appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, after receipt of summons. Therefore, the records and case property, if any, be submitted to the Hon'ble sessions Court under section 209(c) Cr.P.C.

6. The Office is directed to notify the Public Prosecutor about the commitment of the case under Section 209(d) Cr.P.C.
