The petitioner/accused has filed this petition seeking for relaxation of bail condition. The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner/accused complied the condition before the Respondent Police daily at 10.30 AM daily as per order in Crl.MP.No.179/2026, dated 18.06.2026 of this Court. The learned petitioner counsel further submitted that the Petitioner/ Accused is the sole breadwinner of their family. Considering the nature of his work in private company due to the said condition, he is unable to do his daily work and to maintain their family as he has to report at 10.30 AM before the Police Station and hence, his livelihood is affected. Hence, the bail condition may be relaxed.

Notice issued. Reply received from the respondent Police. In the reply stated that the accused regularly signed before the respondent police daily till 12.07.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstance, this Court is of the considered view that the accused has duly complied with the conditions. Further, his livelihood is affected as he is unable to go for any job as he is signing daily. No objections have been raised by the

prosecution. Hence, in the interest of justice, this court is inclined to relax the condition completely on the condition that the accused shall appear in person for the hearing on receipt of the summons before this Court.
