This petition is coming before me for final hearing on 17.04.2026 in the presence of Sri. Katakam Rajender and A. Ramesh, Advocate for the Petitioners No.1 and 2, upon perusing the material papers on record, having been heard and having stood over for consideration to this day, the Court delivered the following:-

:: ORDER ::

1. This petition is filed under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short 'the Act') for dissolution of the marriage in between the petitioners No.1 and 2 by mutual consent.
2. The averments of the petition in brief are that the marriage of petitioners No.1 and 2 was performed on 16.12.2023 at Vannaram

Village, Ramadugu Mandal, Karimnagar District. The said marriage was consummated, but they are not blessed with any children. After the marriage both the petitioners lived happily for a period of six months and thereafter disputes, incompatibility, temperamental differences and misunderstanding, they could not continue their marital relationship, Petitioner No.1 left matrimonial home and has been residing with her parents. In spite of several mediations by the elders, no reconciliation was possible between the petitioners and it is agreed to take divorce by mutual consent. That both the petitioners are living separately from 10.02.2026.

3. The petitioners submit that the petitioner no.2 agreed to pay an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) to the petitioner no.1 towards full and final settlement and permanent alimony and the petitioner No.1 agreed the same. The said amount shall be paid on or before the date of passing of the decree of divorce. As per divorce agreement dated 10.02.2026 gold ornaments and silver articles belonging to both parties have been deposited through their respective elders in KDCC bank, Karimnagar of safe custody and same shall be returned on or before passing of the decree of divorce. That both the parties are at liberty to remarry any person according to their wish and will. That the petitioner no.1 will not have any right to claim any maintenance from the petitioner no.2 in any manner for the past or in future. They further undertake not to institute any civil or criminal

proceedings against each other or their respective family members in future in respect of their matrimonial relationship. Hence, this petition.

4. The case was registered on 16.02.2026 and the statutory period of six months was relaxed on a petition filed by the parties.

5. This Court tried to reconcile both the parties, but in vain.

6. To prove the case of the petitioners, the petitioner No.1 got examined herself as P.W.1 and got marked Ex.P1 to Ex.P5. Ex.P1 is the original wedding card dated 16.12.2023 of petitioners, Ex.P2 is the marriage photos two in number and Ex.P3 is the photocopy of aadhar card of P.W.1, Ex.P4 is the original marriage certificate, dated 24.01.2024 and Ex.P5 is the Original agreement for divorce, dated 10.02.2026. Petitioner No.2 got examined himself as P.W.2 and got marked Ex.P6 i.e., photocopy of aadhar card of P.W.2.

7. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners. Perused the record.

8. Now the point for consideration is:

“Whether the petitioners No.1 and 2 are entitled for grant of decree of divorce by mutual consent by dissolving their marriage performed on 16.12.2023 at Vannaram Village, Ramadugu Mandal, Karimnagar District as prayed for”?

POINT:

9. It is the version of petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2 that their marriage was performed on 16.12.2023 at Vannaram Village, Ramadugu Mandal, Karimnagar District, that the marriage was consummated and they are not blessed with any children. During their

marital life some some differences arose between them in day to day life, due to which they are unable to live together and there is no scope of their reunion or reconciliation, as such, as per the petitioners own consent they filed the present petition to get dissolve their marriage mutually.

10. In this regard the petitioner No.1 examined herself as P.W.1 and Exs.P1 to Exs.P5 are marked. Ex.P1 wedding card, Ex.P2 marriage photos and Ex.P3 photocopy of aadhar card of P.W.1, Ex.P4 Original Marriage Certificate, Ex.P5 original agreement for divorce. Petitioner No.2 examined himself as P.W.2 and got marked Ex.P6 i.e., photocopy of aadhar card of P.W.2.

11. Both P.W's 1 and 2 have stated through their chief affidavits that as per the settlement petitioner no.2 paid Rs. 1,00,000/- to petitioner No.2 towards full and final settlement of permanent alimony and maintenance. All the rights over movable and immovable properties of both the petitioners will be ceased against each other for past or in future and both parties are at liberty to re-marry any person according to their wish and will. Further both the petitioners have exchanged their articles and ornaments which were presented at the time of their marriage. Both the petitioners are unable to live together. Further both the petitioners submitted that in their own interest their marriage may be dissolved by a decree of divorce.

12. Under these circumstances, I hold that it is a fit case to grant decree of divorce by mutual consent by dissolving their marriage as prayed for. The point is answered accordingly.

13. **In the result**, the petition is allowed without costs, granting decree of divorce by mutual consent, dissolving the marriage of the petitioners No.1 and 2 performed on 16.12.2023 at Vannaram Village, Ramadugu Mandal, Karimnagar District.
